## Media Release

### One Step Further

One Step Further is a biennial juried exhibition of contemporary and innovative textile art that Victorian Quilters Inc. have organised since 1998. This exhibition is open to all textile artists in Australia & New Zealand, not just members of Victorian Quilters Inc. As the name implies it is expected that the work entered go 'one step further' in style, technique and presentation but still a quilt, as defined.

The conditions of entry include:

- All art work must be the original work of the maker, and not a copy or variation of another artist's work, and not begun or produced in a class or workshop, or under the supervision of another person.
- Work is not to have been previously exhibited anywhere and must have been completed in the two years prior to being entered into this Exhibition.
- The textile must be predominantly fibre, composed of at least two layers stitched together throughout the piece.
- The outer perimeter of the work must not exceed 7 metres.

The Exhibition of works currently on display at the Kyabram Town Hall were entered in 2020 and the Exhibition was delayed due to the COVID-19 pandemic. The 47 pieces on Exhibition are from residents in each State, The Australian Capital Territory and New Zealand.

The winning piece was Summer Inferno #4 by Sandra Champion, (Tasmania).

**Local Kyabram Textile artist, Sue Reid** Abandonment #4 was Runner Up and another entry by Sue, Hundertwasser Print was highly commended.

Adventure Journal #8: Temple Courtyard by Judy Hooworth, (NSW) also received a highly commended award. Tracks by Judy Robinson Whitty, (Melbourne), received a Judge's Commendation.
